



## THE PRIMARY ERRORS OF CHRISTIANITY

AMERICAN CHRISTIAN CHURCHES HAVE FAILED THIS COUNTRY AND ARE IN DIRECT ALLIANCE WITH THE ROMAN PAPACY'S AGENDA OF COUNTER-REFORMATION AND WORLDWIDE TEMPORAL POWER. ### THE PRIMARY ERRORS

I. The Christian Church interprets the Bible through Greek Platonic Metaphysics instead of the original Ancient Near Eastern Framework of Sympathetic Magic/Aether Science. (Gen. 30:37, 31:9-13, 2 Kings 4:18-37, John 3:14) This is a major reason why there are tens of thousands of confused Christian denominations.

II. The Epistemology of the Christian Church is called Abduction. This method is so arbitrary that it has been used to justify Darwinism and to undermine the Scriptures. If you can use Abduction to "prove" the Trinity and Metaphysics then Darwinists can use it to "prove" millions of years of earth history to provide the best explanation of the fossil record.

III. Postmodernism and the Christian doctrine of the Analogy of Proportionality, i.e. God's alleged transcendence, are exactly the same thing. Postmodernism is simply Christian Epistemology given secular sounding terminology.

IV. The Bible teaches that the Son is begotten of the Father. (Prov. 8:22-31, John 1:1, 10, 14, 18, 3:16, 18, 5:18, 26, Rom. 8:3, 32, Col. 1:15, 18, Heb. 1:2, Rev. 3:14) This absolutely precludes the idea that he could be eternal. The Christians, in their Postmodern irrationalism, will try and convince us that Jesus had a beginningless beginning. The 381 Nicene-Constantinopolitan Creed conflated the being of the Father with that of the Son. This contradicts the generation of the Son as then no being would be generated at all. Thus, their entire approach to John 14:28 is moot.

V. When Jesus was confronted with his relationship to the law of Moses he made very plain in Matthew 5:17 "Think not that I am come to destroy the law." His Jewish followers, the Nazarenes, continued to keep the law of Moses centuries after his death making the Christian interpretation of Eph. 2:14 impossible.

VI. Full Preterism is the only conclusion that can be reached from the Christian view of the law and the annual Feasts of Lev. 23, especially the Fall Feasts. If the Fall Feasts have been fulfilled then the Second Coming and the Resurrection have already happened and we are in an age of Perfection which is laughable. This inherent Preterism and its Perfectionist implications are the foundation of modern Radical Left-Wing Social Justice movements. (See B.B. Warfield, *Studies in Perfectionism*)

VII. Animals know what groups of creatures are their own tribe and which animals are food. This means animals grasp the abstract objects of Species and Genus. The abstract abilities of animals to understand genus and species contradicts Platonic Christianity, because, in their system, only man has a soul and is the only species capable of Metaphysical intelligibility.

VIII. When faced with these irrefutable arguments against their failed institution, Christian Apologists will rage in their desperation and divert the conversation away from the arguments to the popularity and authoritative reputation of their institution. However, Jesus said that his true followers would be few and that the Antichrist religion would be the many. (Matt. 7:13-14, 22) Paul predicted that his disciples in Ephesus would apostatize after his death. (Acts 20:29-30) Revelation 12-13;3 predicts that the dragon would drive the true disciples into obscurity and a universal apostasy would take over where "all the world wondered after the beast." From an honest reading of the New Testament we would expect the "popular" and "authoritative" institution claiming to be followers of Jesus to be the exact Antichrist religion that Jesus and his apostles predicted.

The Christian religion is the Antichrist religion predicted by Jesus and his apostles. The true religion is the Nazarene Messianic Jewish religion of Jesus' first disciples.
